IMPORTANT NOTES

- Applications for fish movement MUST be made at least 2 weeks before** the proposed stocking date to allow the RTC time to respond & for any necessary checks of the site to be made.
- Representatives of the River Tweed Commission may require to be present on site when stocking takes place and it is therefore important that as much notice as possible is given. As a condition of consent the River Tweed Commission require that confirmation of actual stocking dates and timings are notified to the local Water Bailiff at least 24 hours prior to the event, by telephone (contact shown below).**
- It may be a condition of consent that an inspection is made to ascertain whether current or proposed screening arrangements are suitable.**
- There is a presumption against putting transport water into the Tweed river system. A methodology for moving fish from the water on the transport vehicle to the receiving water is therefore required.**
